Youths of Drâa Tafilalet region, actors in Morocco standing against global warming and protecting the environment

In the framework of COP22, Almaouja association launches Monday the 5th and Tuesday the 6th of September 2016 in Ouarzazate its first step of its project *Maroc Made In Terre* by bringing together 55 youths of Drâa Tafilalet region to offer them 'green mediators' training. And so, engage them to lead a pioneering experience in Morocco in favor of environmental protection.

The project *Maroc Made In Terre* aims to keep the spirit of COP22 alive inside schools of Drâa Tafilalet cities (Errachidia, Ouarzazate, Tinghir, Zagora and Midelt) and to increase the level of environmental awareness among youths.

During the project's period *Maroc Made In Terre* which will unfold until April 2017. The 55 green mediators are going to:

- Lead in their living areas (schools, neighborhoods, villages) exemplary actions to fight against global warming and to protect environment.

- Take a collective and participatory reflexion on the ecological future of their region.
